Definition . New Criticism, in simple terms, is a critical movement that propagates the idea of 'art for art's sake'." In focusing on the text itself ("close reading"), New Critics intentionally ignore the author, the reader, and the social context. New Criticism is an approach to literature made popular in the 20th century that evolved out of formalist criticism.

A literary critic or theorist specializes in directions intensified at Stage 2 of critical thinking: evaluation. Theories and movements occur when critics generalize about the experience of reading literature and define it a certain way. They then tend to approach all texts through the lens of their theory.
