Critical thinking skills are necessary to engage in effective patient care in the ICU, and clinicians and educators can help learners develop their reasoning skills by emphasizing the role of inductive reasoning in clinical practice, asking effective questions (using "how" and "why"), acknowledging the impact of cognitive biases in clinical reasoning, and using concept or mechanism maps when teaching.

Clinical reasoning is related to and dependent on critical thinking skills, which are defined as one's capacity to engage in higher cognitive skills such as analysis, synthesis, and self-reflection. This article reviews how an understanding of the cognitive psychological principles that contribute to effective clinical reasoning has led to strategies for teaching clinical reasoning in the ICU.

Teaching Clinical Reasoning and Critical Thinking: From ...

The terms critical thinking and clinical reasoning are often used interchangeably, but there's a slight difference between them. CR is a specific term that usually refers to assessment and management of patient problems at the point of care (e.g., reasoning at the bedside or during clinic visits).
