Dancing Raisins. This Dancing Raisins Science Experiment uses the same chemical reaction behind the well-known homemade volcano project and the self-inflating balloon experiment. When vinegar (an acid) reacts with baking soda (a base) one of the products of the chemical reaction is carbon dioxide, a gas. In the volcano, the gas creates a bubbly solution which comes oozing out of the volcano.

## **Dancing Raisins Science Experiment for Kids**

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Put 3 teaspoons of baking soda in the glass. Then put a layer of raisins over top of the baking soda.

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Plop a couple of raisins into each glass. Don't be alarmed if they sink to the bottom; that's supposed to happen. Turn on some dance music and observe the raisins. Soon they should begin dancing their way to the top of the glass.

Procedure for Dancing Raisins Science Activity Pour some carbonated water into a clear glass. Add some raisins and watch what happens. The raisins begin rising up to the top of the glass and then going back down again.

## **Dancing Raisins Science Experiment - Buggy and Buddy**

1. Start by filling the base about 3/4 full of seltzer (fizzy) water.
2. Toss in a handful of grapes (raisins would work too).
3. It takes a few seconds for the grapes to start dancing but once they do they keep going for quite a while! So cool!

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Instead of using soda like 7Up or Sprite, try using baking soda dissolved in water and vinegar. Dissolve two teaspoons of baking soda into a half cup of water. Add 6-7 raisins to the baking soda/water solution. Slowly pour a tablespoon of vinegar into the mixture and watch the raisins dance!

## **Dancing Worksheets - Kiddy Math**

These bubbles attach to the raisin's rough outer coating. These bubbles make the raisins bouyant, so they begin to rise. When they hit the surface, they lose the bubbles, and fall back down again. The process of the constant dancing gives the teacher (and students) many opportunities to go over what exactly is going on.
